1. Why do you have a Cookies Policy?

The reason we have a Cookies Policy is to explain to you what cookies and similar technologies we use, why we use them, and what you need to do if you want to restrict, block, disable or delete them. Our Cookies Policy is part of, and is subject to, our Privacy Statement.

2. What are cookies and similar technologies?

A cookie is a text file placed on your computer, tablet, mobile phone, or other device ("device") when a person access or uses a website. There are also technologies similar to cookies (e.g. clear gifs) that do the same. Data is collected because it can be necessary to a website's operation, to assess and/or improve its performance, and/or to provide a personalised experience etc.

When you access and/or use our Websites, we will ask you if you will accept cookies and similar technologies from us and/or our third parties. If you choose not to accept them, or if you accept them but subsequently restrict, block, disable or delete some or all of them, you won't have access to many features that make your experience more efficient and some parts of our Websites may not function properly.

4. What cookies collect my data?

We use the following first-party cookies on our Websites. They are placed on your device by us.

hsto	3

This cookie is used to track visitors. It contains the domain, utk, initial timestamp, last timestamp, current timestamp, and session number for each subsequent session.

__hssrc

This cookie is to determine if the user has restarted their browser. This is a session cookie.

hssc

This cookie keeps track of sessions. They allow us to determine if we should increment the session number and timestamps in the _hstc cookie. It contains the domain, viewCount, and session start timestamp. This is a cookie that expires after 30 mins.

hubspotutk

This cookie is used to keep track of a visitor's identity. This cookie is passed to Hubspot on form submissions and used when de-duplicating contacts. Expires after 10 years.

__ga

This cookie is used to distinguish users. Expires after 2 years.

__gat

This cookie is used to throttle the request rate - limiting the collection of data on high traffic sites. It expires after 1 minute.

__gid

This cookie is used to distinguish users. It expires after 24 hours.

crumb, ss_cvisit, ss_cpvisit, ss_cid

These are cookies used by Squarespace, a web publishing company which we have built our site on, to track use of the website and allow some of the site's features.

crumb: session cookie; ss_cid expiration: 2 years; ss_cpvisit expires: 2 years; ss_cvisit: 30 mins; ss_cvr expires: 2 years;ss_cvt expires: 30 mins

cfduid

This cookie is used to identify trusted web traffic. It does not correspond to any user id in the web application, nor does the cookie store any personally identifiable information. This cookie is set by Hubspot and their privacy policy can be found athttps://legal.hubspot.com/privacy-policy.

UserMatchHistory

This cookie is used for Linkedin Ad and expires after 6 months.https://www.linkedin.com/legal/privacy-policy

BizoID

This cookie is used for LinkedIn Ad analytics. This cookie is stored for 6 months.https://www.linkedin.com/legal/privacy-policy

bcookie

Browser ID cookie/ Share button and ad tags. It expires after 1 year.https://www.linkedin.com/legal/cookie-table

fr

This cookie contains encrypted Facebook ID and Browser ID. It expires after 3 months.https://www.facebook.com/about/privacy/update?ref=old_policy

lang

This cookie saves the language settings of the user.https://www.linkedin.com/legal/privacy-policy

lidc

This cookie is used for routing. It expires after 1 day.https://www.linkedin.com/legal/privacy-policy
